You seem to be elsewhere

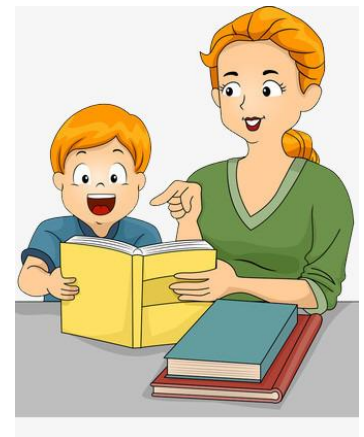
Mummy have I told you
