PACKED LUNCHES

Please make sure your child's lunchbox is named on the outside of the lunch box. At croft we encourage healthy eating, and size appropriate lunches, recommended packed lunches are ½ to 1 slice of bread for sandwiches or a wrap or a dunker, 1 piece of fruit, yoghurt and small snack. Please only pack what you think your child is capable of eating.

Nappies, Wipes and Nappy Sacks

If your child wears nappies please ensure that you provide enough nappies, wipes and nappy sacks for their session. We do send dirty nappies home as, unfortunately, we are unable to dispose of nappies at Preschool. Please remember to check your child's bag. Nappies are more absorbent than pull ups, pull ups are more beneficial when toilet training.

Please can you make sure your child brings a named outdoor coat, we enjoy playing outside whatever the weather.

Each week we have a show day, where the children can bring something from home to show their friends, please can we ask that you put their names on it, and also encourage your child to bring only one small item to show

Our next fundraising Raffle will be for Easter, it will be drawn on Monday 30 March at Minis

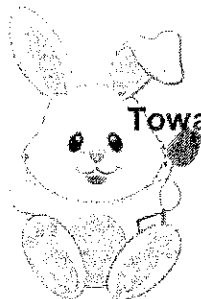


Sponsored Easter Hunt

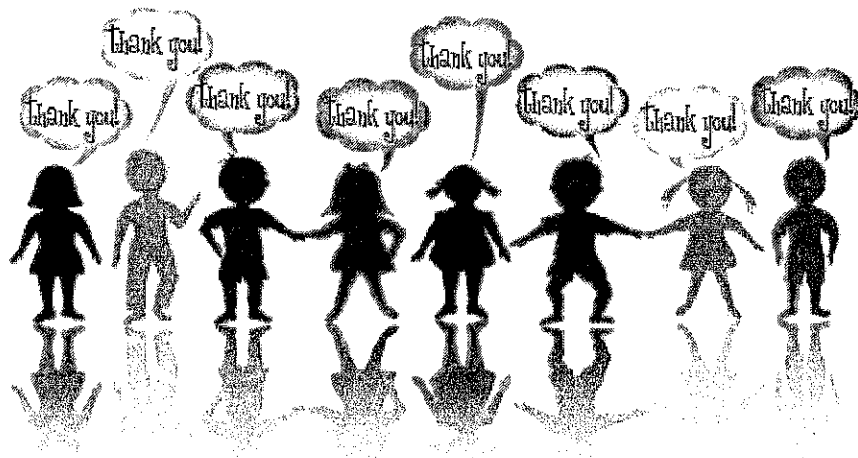
