WE WILL CONTINUE TO STAY OPEN AS LONG AS THE GOVERNMENT ALLOW US TO. WE ARE TAKING ALL THE NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS AND ALL THE PREVIOUS ARRANGEMENTS ARE STILL IN PLACE.

Children will be met at the door and their temperature will be taken and recorded
(Sorry but no parents/carers to enter the building at the present time)

Regular hand washing routines

Regular cleaning of all facilities and resources

Parents to maintain social distancing when dropping off and picking up

At the end of the session children will be brought out to the parents/carers

Please respect the government guidelines and self-isolate immediately if:

- You have any symptoms of coronavirus (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste)
- You've tested positive for coronavirus – this means you have coronavirus
 - Someone you live with has symptoms or tested positive
- Someone in your support bubble has symptoms and you've been in close contact with them since their symptoms started or during the 48 hours before they started
- Someone in your support bubble tested positive and you've been in closed contact with them since they had the test or in the 48 hours before their test.

The self-isolation period is 10 days.

Thank you for your support over this difficult time, the health and welfare of your children is vitally important to us.

PACKED LUNCHES

Please make sure your child's lunchbox is named on the outside of the lunch box. At croft we encourage healthy eating, with this in mind please can we remind parents to cut grapes in half-length ways.

Nappies, Wipes and Nappy Sacks

If your child wears nappies please ensure that you provide enough nappies, wipes and nappy sacks for their session. We do send dirty nappies home as, unfortunately, we are unable to dispose of nappies at Preschool. Please remember to check your child's bag.

COATS AND INDOOR SHOES



Please can you make sure your child brings a named outdoor coat, we enjoy playing outside whatever the weather. Please can your child bring a pair of indoor shoes to change into when they come into preschool to help keep the floor areas clear. Thank You

ILLNESS AT CROFT

We ask that any child that is ill and showing any signs of Covid 19 does not attend Croft and that they are tested and the necessary required isolation period is taken.

If anybody contracts Covid 19 and attends Croft Preschool then we will have to close the whole setting for 10 days self-isolation

If your child has a bout of sickness/diarrhoea please keep them off for at least 48 hours after the last bout of illness (eg if your child is sick at 10am Sunday, please do not return them until after Tuesday Lunchtime.) Our staff are not immune to illness and should they come down with a sickness/diarrhoea bug we would have to close.

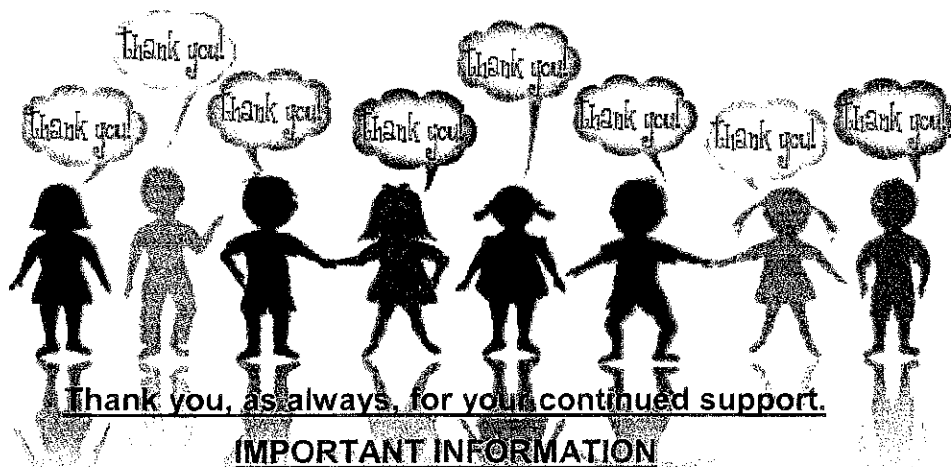
